<b>Please, explain your motivation to become CDN Executive Committee member:</b>

Thus my first event as a participant quickly grew into membership in a prep-team for the next event, and then to membership in a WG, and so forth. CDN have created a great encouraging and supportive Green community, and now I strive to keep up this level and join the development of the organisation in which I believe. Being an Executive Committee member is one way to do this. With my skills and experience I want to help make the CDN community stronger and more resilient, empower activist teams, as well as to spread the influence of Green ideas across Eastern Europe where the political environment is especially turbulent and green agenda is very challenging to promote.</p>

<p>Participating in the regional event in Belarus "Urban Steps for Resilient Future" was my first CDN experience. After that I was a prep-team member of the training "Thinking and Acting through Green Prism" and "RUMB Regional Roundtable" in Kyiv. Recently, I participated in the development of an online-course "Art as a Shelter" and coordinated the implementation of a Local action in Ukraine as a part of "Art for Freedom" project. Besides, I have been a member of the RUMB Working group since the beginning of 2019.</p>
<b>Being a member of the Executive Committee is a very demanding task that requires inter-cultural competences, working under pressure, deadlines, in non-familiar environment, dedication to the goals, and this being online work. Please explain briefly your ability to respond to these challenges and requirements:</b>

I understand the responsibility and special features of being an EC member and I am ready to handle them. I have previously worked under the pressure and under severe deadlines implementing educational projects, as well as participating in CDN activities, so I can imagine the workload well.
